

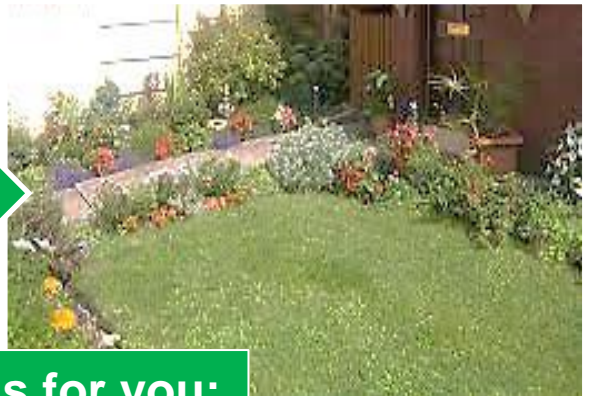
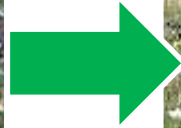

Tenant Scrutiny 8– Managing untidy gardens

What did we do? The Tenant Scrutiny panel carried out surveys, interviews and internet searches to find out more about the best ways to manage untidy gardens. Recommendations have been made for KNH and CWC to work together to try and reduce the number of untidy gardens in Kirklees.

A fairer assisted garden scheme for those who need it

Tenants may be able to ask for gardens that are easier to look after.

A gardening training scheme for young people and others may be looked into along with a low-cost gardening service.
